- B. Gibson presented that Casill Motors was willing to reduce the price by \$5K for their advertisement on the front of the truck and the back of the trailer. Lynch Ford was not willing to donate the \$5K for advertising. Attendees discussed and agreed that other businesses (non-vehicle dealers) could also donate money for advertising on the front/back of the vehicales, but not on the sides which is reserved for Prarie logos.
- In light of new information on gasoline trucks, B. Gibson asked if PMA was willing to consider a gasoline truck? Attendees discussed. T. Johnson motioned that the truck committee make the "best" decision on a new truck purchase and bring to next PMA meeting for approval. J. Rigdon 2nd.
